PROPOSED INCREASE OF MEMBERSHIP SUBSCRIPTION FOR 1973

To amend Rule 3(d) to read (with effect from January 1973): Rule 3(d). The subscription for Ordinary Members shall be £1.25p per calendar year.....

In the above respect, I think that your attention should be drawn to the following facts:-

- (a) The Society is already heavily subsidised to the extent of some £25. by a few members who pay amounts over and above their annual subscription. A further £25. is granted by the Surrey Education Committee and £50. by the Leatherhead Urban District Council, but there is no guarantee that these will continue next year
- (b) The cost of printing last year's Proceedings worked out at 63p per copy (not including the Index to Vol. 2).

and regrettably some members who personally collected both of these have not yet paid their subscriptions of 75p due last January.

- (c) Subscriptions so far collected this year have fallen approximately £70. short of the printing bill. Next year with continued inflation and V.A.T. the printing costs will be at least 70p per copy.
- (d) Those of you who are members of the National Trust will already know that the membership subscription is being increased by 50% next year.
